Dear Friends of the Russian-Speaking Community:

The Russian-Speaking Youth Leadership Conference (RSYLC) needs your help. Our all-volunteer Fundraising Committee asks you to support the Eighteenth Russian-Speaking Youth Leadership Conference scheduled for April 29, 2014 at Clackamas Community College.

The purpose of the conference is to show participants how many career options and opportunities are possible after high school graduation, to promote youth leadership and development of the Russian-Speaking Community in the Pacific Northwest.

The Russian-speaking population in the Portland Metropolitan Area has been growing rapidly since 1989. It is now approaching 150,000 residents. This population growth has brought many challenges: a disproportionate high school dropout rate among Russian-speaking youth; a lack of culturally appropriate services for Russian-speaking immigrants and refugees, and a lack of awareness about community norms and laws.

For the past 17 years the RSYLC has played an instrumental role in bringing several thousand Russian-speaking youth together to discuss these challenges and develop meaningful ways to address them on a community-wide level via youth, parent, school and community involvement.

Conference participants have included high school students from school districts in Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington & Marion counties in Oregon and Clark County in Washington. Our budget for this year is \$18,000. This includes funds for art awards and college scholarships, as well as conference operations.
