RSYLC Student Code of Conduct

18th Annual Russian-Speaking Youth Leadership Conference

Clackamas Community College, April 29, 2014

- Only registered students will be admitted to the conference.
- All students must travel to the conference and return to school on school buses with chaperones.
 - NO private transportation is allowed.
 - Students who violate this rule will not be admitted to the conference.
