Chaperone Responsibilities

Pre-Conference:

- Meet with your students prior to the conference to go over behavioral expectations, explain the dress code and answer any questions about the conference.
- Assist students in completing scholarship applications – translate documents, if necessary.
- Please, remind you students, performance etiquette is required. No heckling, swearing or gestures shall be made in or around the performance area.
- If your student/s participate in the Talent Contest, screen their performance and fill out Talent Contest Proposal Application.
- Conference ends at 2:00 PM, please, arrange busses accordingly.

Day of the Conference:

- Make sure that all students are dressed appropriately.
- Review conference expectations with students.

At the Conference:

- Check in at the registration desk **upon arrival**.
 No students will be allowed at the registration desk.
- Distribute conference packets and nametags.
- Instruct students to carry programs and wear nametags at all times during the conference.
- Maintain direct supervision of your students **AT ALL TIMES**.
